Goalkeeper ID Academy (in conjunction with Titan College Bound ID Camp)

The Goalkeeper ID Camp is one-day camp offering boys and girls who are entering 2020 Fall Grades 9-12 to train with Coach Jerry Hare, HGA Director and the Goalkeeper Coach at Westminster College along with Girish Thakar, Men's & Women's Head Soccer Coach and current members of Westminster College Soccer program. The Goalkeeper ID Academy is for the serious goalkeeper ambitions of playing collegiate soccer. We recommend this camp for anyone who plays competitively at the club level or competes to play for the varsity team at their high school. This camp will introduce all goalkeepers to technical and tactical elements necessary to play soccer at Westminster College and the college level. The camp is specifically designed so that players are exposed to Hare Goalkeeper Academy and the Westminster College coaching staff for development and evaluation purposes. The Goalkeeper ID Camp includes on-field instruction, campus presentation, campus tour, lunch, small-sided games and full-field games. At the conclusion of camp, you will have better understanding on what it takes to compete at the collegiate level.

GK Residential Academy (in conjunction with Titan Residential Soccer Camp)

The Goalkeeper Residential Academy Camp is a residential & commuter camp open to boys and girls, ages 10-18 who are dedicated to goalkeeping. This camp is designed for the serious goalkeepers, who have aspirations to play soccer at the high school and collegiate levels. This camp will be conducted by Jerry Hare, HGA Director and the Goalkeeper Coach at Westminster College along with members of Westminster College goalkeeping unit as assistants. The camp consists of morning technical training and speed & agility training sessions followed by afternoon sessions with field players that will specifically deal with in-game management techniques in small-sided games. Topics covered include controlling/instructing your defense, set plays (corner kicks, free kicks), restarts and wall building, penalty kicks, keeper positioning in relation to the ball in play. During evening sessions, players will participate in full-field games. Coach Jerry Hare and Westminster College Head Coach Girish Thakar will be continually monitoring and mentoring the keepers individually throughout the games.

The HGA philosophy revolves around developing the keepers both mentally and physically. The instruction and activities are designed to challenge all keepers both in terms of technique and decision making ability. As always, along with learning, we strive to ensure a fun environment and will provide a variety of activities that will help players develop a sound keeper mentality, refine techniques and even enjoy improving critical goalkeeper specific fitness levels. This camp will push goalkeepers to their limits to be successful. There is a 1:8 coach-to-player ratio, so as to sharpen the individual development of each player. The camp's professional staff will train and mentor the goalkeepers and ensure that they maximize their potential and improve their skills before leaving the camp.

In addition to teaching the technical and tactical skills required by goalkeepers, the Goalkeeper Academy Camp also focuses on teaching the goalkeepers to establish a presence and be leaders on the field. Most activities are performed in a game like environment to ensure that the goalkeepers understand when to apply the technical and tactical skills. At the HGA camps, goalkeepers learn that it is as important to prevent shots, as it is to make a save. Off the field the learning continues with lectures, video analysis, question & answer sessions. A high level of competition, plus outstanding instruction, offers an unparalleled learning opportunity for goalkeepers. The written evaluations will be given to the goalkeepers at the end of camp.
